Absence Procedures

If your child is going to be absent from school, please ensure that you make contact with the school office or enter the absence into Compass. If you are unsure how to use this feature on Compass, please contact Mrs Higgins in our office.

Mobile Phones, Devices and Wearable Technologies

Students who bring a mobile phone, ipads (or equivalent), or wearable technology (such as smart watches, fit bits, etc) to school are asked to leave these at the office when they arrive in the morning and then collect them from the office at the end of the day. Mrs Higgins now has a book where students sign their devices in and out each day.

Allergies

We have several students in the school with severe allergies, some that require epi-pens to be at school each day. It is crucial that students and staff do not have any nut or egg products in their lunch boxes. Parents, please contact your child's teacher if you are planning on supplying any food for the class (eg birthday cake) well before the date. These foods must not contain nuts or eggs (even if there isn't a child with a severe allergy in the class) and all ingredients must be listed.

A reminder that all students with severe allergies (anaphylaxis) and asthma are required to have an up-to-date management plan signed by the doctor. A copy of the plan must be given to Mrs Higgins in the school office.

Ludo

Ludo is provided by CatholicCare, in partnership with St Brigid's. It is open to students from 3–5 years old. Ludo is open 7.00am–6.00pm, 50 weeks a year, including school terms and holidays. Children in Kindergarten can access two days of care on their non–school days. For further information, please call CatholicCare on 62 086 012.

Drinks at school

We expect that students bring water only in their drink bottles to school - unless otherwise advised by a medical professional. This is to be consumed during learning times (as appropriate), recess and lunch.

At times, some families may choose to send a drink to accompany the child's lunch. Acceptable examples are: Up and Go, Fruit Box, or a milk drink

Unacceptable examples are: Energy drinks and fizzy drinks.

Fruit Break

We expect that during Fruit Break students consume only fruit or vegetables. One exception to this is cheese. We have fruit available in the office for students who do not have fruit. Students can also swap their fruit for a different piece of fruit from the office supply.


