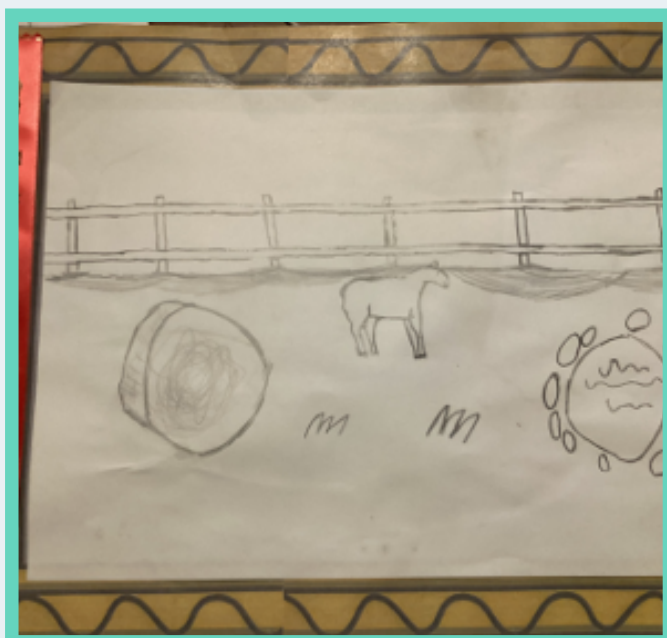
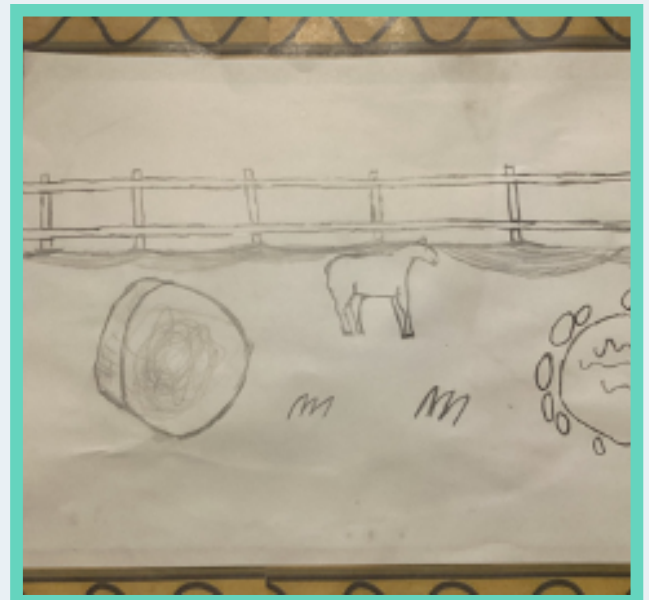
Hamilton Show
